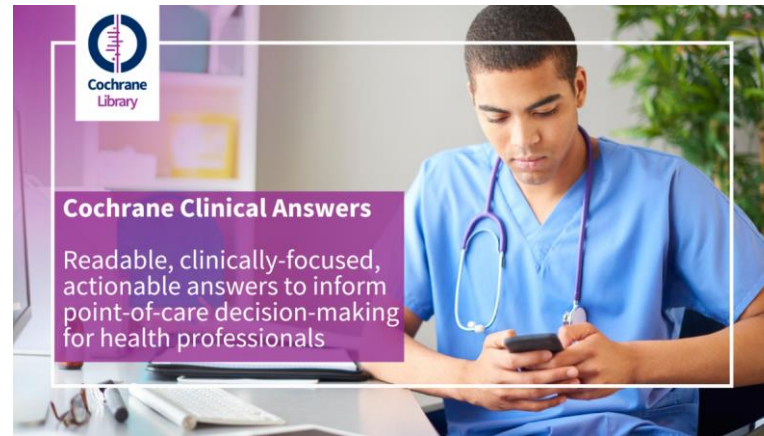

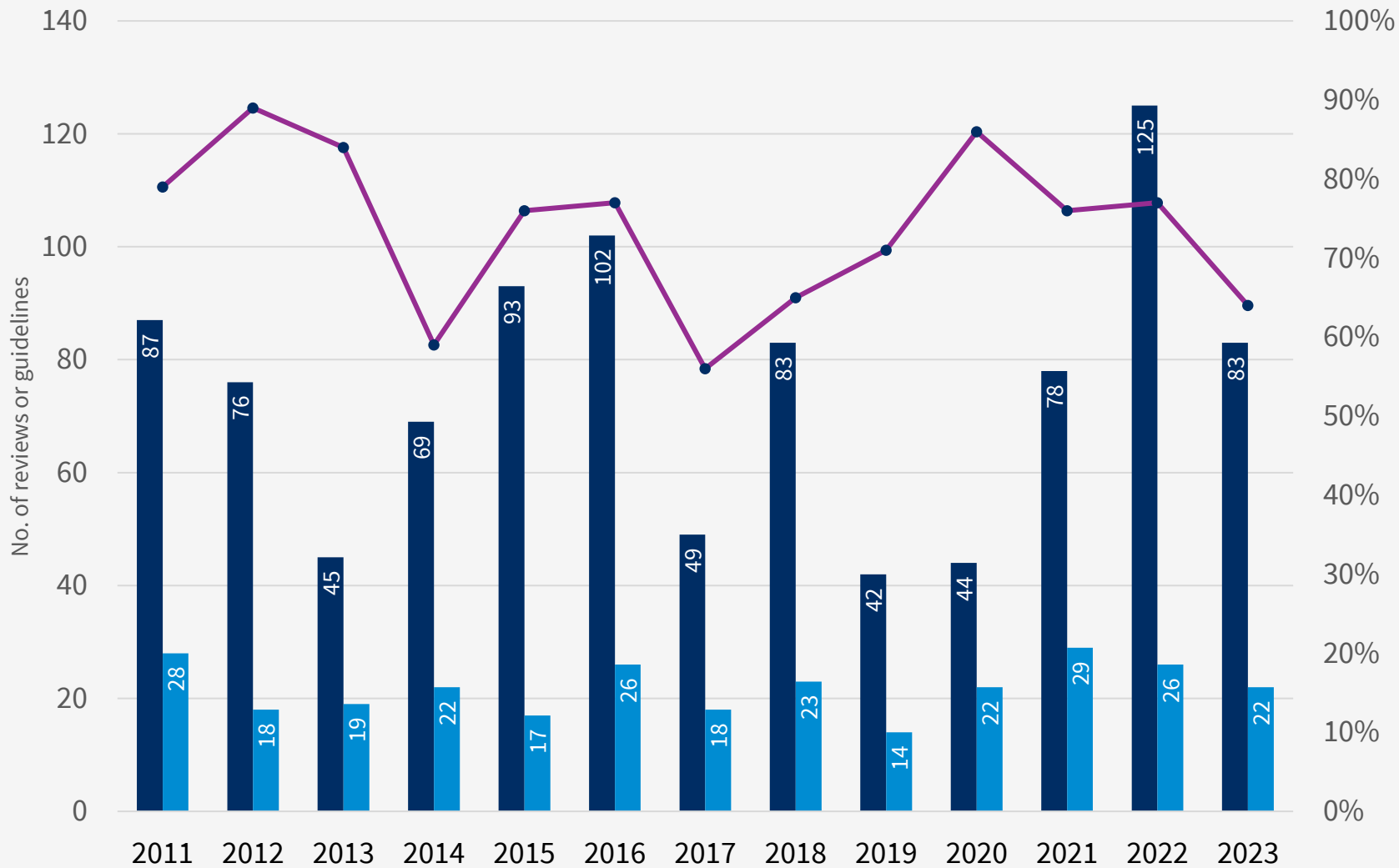

- Open access: ambitions and challenges
- What we ARE doing:
 - Our plain language summaries are free and translated into multiple languages
 - All Cochrane reviews are free 12 months after publication + all protocols are free immediately
 - Free access to all content in 100+ low- and middle-income countries
 - Data associated with Cochrane Reviews can now be downloaded in standard formats, such as CSV and RIS (FAIR Principles)
